JUNE MEETING SUCCESSFUL

If you missed the June Homeowner's meeting, the minutes are posted on the window of the guard shack at the entrance. Sheriff Joel Kerns spoke to everyone regarding the recent rash of break-ins in the area. He welcomes your phone calls to report illegal entrances to your home, car and/or storage facility on your property. He stressed that one thing that helps our area is our regulation of one road in and one road out. That helps to narrow down the search area.

The monthly cost of the new trash service has now been reduced from \$24.50 to \$18.00 per month. The serial numbers on the blue barrels have been assigned to homeowners.

A representative from US Alert spoke about their security camera system—cost to be approximately \$4,000. We still have one other company to consider. Their cost is around \$3,000.

Among the other items discussed were approval of the budget, roadwork, cleaning of bar ditches, painting and replacing road signs and fire protection.
